Venantius Fortunatus was a sixth-century Latin poet in the Merovingian Court and a bishop of the early Catholic Church. His major works include hymns for the Church, panegyrics to four Merovingian kings, praise poems for divine as well as contemporary figures, and the Vita Sancti Martini , a long narrative poem depicting the life of St. Martin.
