P. eople affected by Parkinson ' s can develop problems with communication and with eating, drinking and swallowing (dysphagia). As well as the more obvious motor changes, people with Parkinson ' s may also experience non-motor changes that can impact on communication and more general quality of life, including depression, anxiety, apathy, fatigue, pain, sleep disturbance and cognitive changes i ii iii.

This could be as a result of Parkinson ' s disease or other progressive neurological conditions, such as motor neurone disease Dyspraxia (verbal) – An articulation disorder which affects a person ' s ability to plan and execute speech movements in the absence of muscle weakness, paralysis, sensory loss, comprehension deficit or ataxia, for example after a stroke
