The International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code was first published by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) in 1965 and is now updated every two years. As of January 2004, the Code has been mandatory for the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) signatory states, effectively making it a global rulebook for the sea transport of Dangerous Goods.

IMDG CODE | IMDG Code Support

IMDG Code or International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code is accepted by MSC (Maritime Safety Committee) as an international guideline to the safe transportation or shipment of dangerous goods or hazardous materials by water on vessel. IMDG Code is intended to protect crew members and to prevent marine pollution in the safe transportation of hazardous materials by vessel.

The IMDG code became mandatory in 2004 and applies to all ships governed by SOLAS and to cargo ships under 500grt as well as to any other parties involved in the transport of Dangerous Goods. All ships carrying marine pollutants are subject to the IMDG code.

The International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code was adopted by IMO resolution A.716 (17) and published in 1965. Was recommended to governments for adoption or for use as the basis for national regulations in pursuance of obligations under SOLAS regulation VII/1.4 and MARPOL Annex III regulation 1 (3).
