KS1 Literacy - Acrostic Poem Maker This interactive activity helps pupils to create their own acrostic poem. In an acrostic poem, the first letter of each line spells a word. Pupils firstly write their chosen word, which is then spelled out vertically. Pupils can brainstorm words or phrases that describe their word or idea, and then add these to the lines that begin with the same letters to create their poem.

KS1 Literacy - Acrostic poem maker | Teaching Resources

An acrostic poem is a poem where the first letter of each consecutive line spells a word, normally related to the theme of the poem. Acrostic poems are a great entry point into creative writing for young children. They make the task of writing and writing poetry a lot less daunting and the structure is a good way of keeping KS1 children focused.

What are acrostic poems? Acrostic poems are a style of poetry where each letter at the beginning of a line is used to spell a word when you read it vertically. It's normally the first, but it could be any other letter on the line. That word is normally the subject or topic of the poem. For example, here is an acrostic poem about a cat: Cute Aloof Tabby
