You Don ' t Have to Teach the Color Wheel Anymore - The Art ...

Ask your class to try and replicate the colors on the color wheel template by mixing different paints together and painting the blank color wheel. The Color Wheel: A color wheel is an arrangement of different color hues around a circle that shows the relationship between primary, secondary, and tertiary colors. The most common colors found on a traditional color wheel are as follows: red, orange, yellow, yellow-green, green, blue-green, blue, blue-violet, violet, mauve, mauve-pink, and pink.

The Colour Wheel | Teaching Resources

Teaching children about color theory, even the most basic concepts, sets students up with color mixing techniques to be reinforced with later lessons throughout the year. Color Through the Grades Kindergarten and first graders explores color by identifying the primary colors (red, blue and yellow) and begin basic mixing techniques to create secondary colors (orange, green, purple).

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How to Teach COLOR | Deep Space Sparkle

Show your child the circle and all the different color names. Explain that you are going to mix paint with them to create a color wheel. Tell your child when any of the primary colors are mixed with another primary color, a secondary color results. The secondary colors are orange, purple, and green.

Making a color wheel with children teaches them many skills and concepts. It teaches them about primary colors, it teaches them about color mixing and it teaches them about the secondary colors, tertiary colors and complementary colors (or contrasting colors).
